

## Big Goose, Little Goose

Finished 12 inches

### To make Geese

Assorted geese fabric and background fabric for paper-piecing.

For generous cutting suggestions:

Large goose - cut four at 7-1/4" sq, cut once on the diagonal. You need four triangles. You may use four different fabrics or make all four triangles the same.

Small goose - Using the same fabrics that match your large goose fabric, cut a 4-1/2" sq and cut once on diagonal.

Background fabric - cut six squares at 4-1/2 inches and cut once on the diagonal.

1. Using the paper-piecing pattern on the back and referring to instructions on paper-piecing on page 2 and 3, create 4 blocks from the pattern. Trim to 6-1/2 inches.

2. Sew the 4 segments together, matching the center seams. Remember to keep all the triangles "flying" in the same direction.

Press seams open.
